Developed and delivered by our highly-experienced senior leaders and accredited facilitators, our NQT Development Programme will inspire and empower newly-qualified teachers to develop their classroom pedagogy, enhancing pupil outcomes and ensuring challenge and engagement for all learners.

Our four-day programme, spread across the academic year, will provide teachers with the knowledge and skills to confidently and innovatively lead learning in the classroom, manage behaviour for learning and meet the needs of different pupils. Incorporating reflection, coaching and practical learning experiences, our NQTDP has been developed to meet the specific needs of local teachers to help participants to achieve personal and professional goals. Through consultation with Heads and Mentors, the course can be personalised to the needs and requirements of participating schools.

Our practical, hands-on training programme, focussed on the Teacher Standards, consists of four development days spread across the year:

Thursday 11th October 2018 9:00-4:00

- Successful Communication and Behaviour Management.

Thursday 17th January 2019 9:00-4:00

- Effective Learning and Teaching.

Thursday 14th March 2019 9:00-4:00

- Assessment.

Thursday 20th June 2019 9:00-4:00

- Meeting the Needs of All Learners.

Sessions will be held in our onsite Training and Education Centre.

Audience: Teachers at the start of their career (up to two years' teaching experience).
